



Régulations of internal method of Duiktank Transfo

The operator of Duiktank Transfo performs a regulation of internal method to ensure a good operation; these regulations are clearly communicated with the clientele of Duiktank Transfo.

1. General provisions

1. The main language in Duiktank Transfo is Dutch.
2. The managing board has the right to prohibit access to every person who appears to be a danger to the safety and health of the other attendees – drunkenness, disturbance, failure to comply with the regulations, manifestations, gatherings, to block passage, behave indecently, throwing garbage, contagious diseases or ailments, persons with unhealed wounds, persons who -for other reasons- are in a state that justifies their refusal; this list is not exhaustive.
3. Non-divers can only access the entrance hall and the cafeteria; only divers and supervisors can access the changing rooms and the waterfront.
4. Animals, except assistance dogs to the wet area, aren't admitted in the venue.
5. It's only allowed to change in the changing rooms for that purpose. They can only stay there for the necessary time.
6. The individual lockers must be locked while diving. Therefor you need a 50eurocent coin.
7. The changing rooms should be kept clean.
8. The changing rooms must be cleared latest 30 minutes after closing the diving zone.
9. Divers are allowed in the pool until 1 hour before closing time.
10. Inside the venue it is forbidden to peddle, display merchandise, sell nor offered as an advertisement; with the exception if it is approved by the management.
11. It is forbidden to use food- and drinkware at the waterfront of the Duiktank Transfo.
12. The audience should behave after the guidelines that are brought to their knowledge by the staff of Duiktank Transfo.
13. All visitors are responsible for the damage caused by them, according to articles 1382 of the Civil Code. Associations can be held responsible. Instructors, leaders, monitors from associations are responsible for the people under their control.
14. All damage can lead to payment of compensation equal to the repairing cost or the costs to replace the damage.
15. We are not responsible for (personal) objects that are lost or stolen during the stay at our venue.
16. Because of the fact the visitors are in the venue they declare to pursue and to have knowledge of the regulations and their responsibility on damage to the planting, buildings, installations, goods and third parties. The Staff of Duiktank Transfo have the right to perform their check task at all times.
17. Access to Duiktank Transfo can be deny to all who's behaviour begets discredit or for them who don't follow the regulations. Therefor the regulations are on a visible place at the entrance of Duiktank Transfo.

- 18.** The R.D. of 31/03/1987 that forbid smoking in public places must be observed.
- 19.** The use of the venue is only allowed for the activity that the management announced; unless the management agreed on an activity submitted by the customer. The announced or pre-arranged time schedules should be strictly observed.
- 20.** It's forbidden to perform any kind of publicity accept if the management agrees.
- 21.** For all visitor in Duiktank Transfo apply all regulations and they need to be pursued.
- 22.** Duiktank Transfo is not responsible for injuries or illnesses.
- 23.** The Staff appointed by the management watch over punctual compliance of the regulations.
- 24.** All cases that are not provided in this regulation fall within the competence of the management.
- 25.** Adjustments or changes to this regulation are only within the competence of the managing board of Duiktank Transfo.
- 26.** The diver will use the venue as it was his own.
- 27.** The diver accepts that his name can be included in the customer base of Duiktank Transfo. Corresponding to the law of processing of personal data, the diver has the right to look into the file at all times, to correct his data or delete and oppose the use of the data for direct marketing purposes. The responsible for the processing of these data with whom the diver can exercise these rights is Hugo Landré (Knokstraat 3 in 8570 Vichte). This clause applies also to pictures, mentioned in article 28 of these regulations.
- 28.** Duiktank Transfo is owner of all pictures taken in the context of the venue.
- 29.** Before entering Duiktank Transfo all divers should have read and signed the regulations of internal method and the safety regulations.
- 30.** It is also not allowed to:
 - ✓ Make excessive noise with crying and ranting.
 - ✓ Run at the waterfront or in the changing rooms.
 - ✓ Push, fight or perform other violent acts.
 - ✓ Take actions that are not consistent with good behaviour and customs.

2. Safety regulations

Access to Duiktank Transfo

31. To gain access during public hours you have to be in possession of an entry ticket, multi-pass card or subscription. This has to be shown at the request of the staff of Duiktank Transfo or the local police.
32. Access can be denied if the maximum occupancy rate is reached.
33. Associations who visit Duiktank Transfo in non-public hours, must provide their own rescue diver fully equipped at the waterfront to provide safety; the rescue diver must elucidate/execute the safety regulations.
34. The diver must have a medical statement, not older than 12 months, that allow diving. If he does not possess this, the diver is liable/responsible for all consequences in event of an accident.
35. All divers need to be insured for performing diving activities.
36. The diver diving in Duiktank Transfo, allows Duiktank Transfo, to take action in case of an accident (call 112, evacuate the venue,...)
37. Every diver must take a shower fully equipped before entering the waterfront; also must the diver rinse his equipment, shoes and fins. Therefore we have showers and a foot bath on the third floor.
38. Non-divers who want to enter the waterfront can pass through the foot bath or wear shoe covers.
39. Youth divers must always be accompanied by a supervisor. Youth divers are only allowed to dive when accompanied by a monitor who has the necessary license; this according to the rules of the federation.

Diving activities

40. The diver is responsible for his buddy or buddies. The diver is close to his diving team and if there is a problem he is the first to react.
41. To dive in Duiktank Transfo you have to follow the rules of your diving federation as well as the rules of Duiktank Transfo.
42. Divers need to dive with equipment in line of their license.
43. If two rules contradict, the rule that offer the most safety has to be followed.
44. The minimum diving team composition:

➤ First diving experience/ initiation	at least has to dive with	CMAS Dive instructor
➤ Non-licenced diver (dive 1 and 2)	at least has to dive with	CMAS Dive instructor
➤ Non-licenced diver (dive 3,4,...)	at least has to dive with	CMAS 4*D
➤ 1*D (till 15 dives)	at least has to dive with	CMAS 4*D
➤ 1*D (from 15 dives)	at least has to dive with	CMAS 3*D
➤ 2*D	at least has to dive with	CMAS 2*D
➤ 3*D	at least has to dive with	See above

46. Divers who dive with gas mixtures must always respect a maximum ppO₂ of 1,4 bar.

47. All divers who dive with a gas mixture different from normal air are self-responsible to analyse the mixture before diving.

48. On the timetable stated closing time there will be a sound signal to request to leave the water.

49. In public hours there is a time limit of 60 minutes in the diving zone.

50. The times agreed with groups, clubs, associations has to be followed strictly.

51. Furthermore, it is not allowed to, among other things:

- ✓ To contaminate the water in any way.
- ✓ To dive outside the no-deco time (although a safety stop is recommended).
- ✓ To hamper or harass other divers.

52. All divers and their supervisors should comply by the guidelines of the staff of Duiktank Transfo.

53. Exercising rescue procedures should always be reported to the rescue diver of Duiktank Transfo(staff).
